## Dear Sir/Madam,

Juliet Doling has been a Corangamite CMA volunteer for the past 14 months working in the Geelong region with the WaterWatch program collecting data to inform waterway condition.

She has been a pleasure to work with and has brought energy and ideas to the program. I would like to share my experiences with Juliet as I believe they align with the Deakin Leadership Hallmark award by contributing to communities through sustainable and effective leadership.

## Standard 1. Proven ability to lead diverse people and projects

Juliet participated in a "Come and Try WaterWatch" event aimed at raising awareness of waterway health 2 years ago and since then she has mobilized a team of students to do water testing on the Waurn Ponds Creek, a priority waterway for the Corangamite CMA, and the constructed wetlands at Waurn Ponds Creek campus. To do this successfully she shared her vision for students volunteering for a healthy environment with Deakin Grounds Manager Luke Primus, Sustainability Manager Zoe Roloff as well as academics and students. As a result, the team she manages has had training and provided with the resources needed for water testing with information uploaded to a publicly available data portal.

Juliet has extended the creek testing to monitoring of the constructed wetlands. To do this she considered occupational health and safety, student availability, and contributed to a monitoring plan for the activities.

Her energy and enthusiasm has created the conditions for successful team building, and her communication skills has mobilized this great team.

## Standard 2. Evidence of personal and social impact through leadership

The work Juliet has done has a positive influence with her fellow students gaining greater skills and knowledge in waterway health.
